### Digital Geodata

- Collecting
- Cataloging
- Providing

### Major and largest map collection in Germany (ongoing)

- 1,2 Mio. analogue maps (including the collection of the Imperial German General Staff)
- 250.000 digital maps
- 154.000 views
- 35.000 atlases
- 800 globes und reliefs
- 38.000 volumes specialist literature

## Focal points

- old and modern topographical map series (worldwide; paper and digital)
- town plans (worldwide)
- fortification and military battle maps (Europe)
- geological, historical, archeological, health, or language atlases and maps (worldwide)
- globes
- Prussia
- maps of German speaking regions

### ***Specialized Information Service Cartography and Geodata*** (Fachinformationsdienst Kartographie & Geobasisdaten

– FID Karten)

- funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG) since 2016 / 3rd project phase
- target group: researchers from all spatial sciences
- aims: improving the digital research environment & extending the support
  - infrastructures (catalogues, bibliography, repository)
  - customized information on cartographic materials (literature, geodata incl. scans)
- all German scientific institutions are invited to apply for support

### **New Division *Digital Cartography and Geodata***

- collecting current and historical digital geodata
  - official (legal deposit)
  - research
- national metadata catalogue for analogue and digital geodata
  - ongoing, not just historic titles

## Collecting geodata

- preserving and linking current born digital geodata (official, collaborative, research)
- making analogue geodata digitally available
  - digitization (841 x 1189mm (DIN A0), resolution up to 1.000 dpi)
  - Deutsche Digitale Bibliothek (**DDB**) archiving and presentation of digital images (**Kitodo**)
  - collaboration for georeferencing and vectoring (researchers, companies, crowd, AI)

## Cataloging geodata

- **PICA3** metadata format used by many German, Dutch and other libraries
- Machine-Readable Cataloging Format (**MARC 21**) international library metadata (exchange) format
- Ressource Description & Access (**RDA**) International cataloging guideline; add. for cartographic resources; (**RDA D-A-CH**) <https://sta.dnb.de/doc/RDA-R-KART>
  - no recommendations for cataloging digital geodata so far (work in progress)
    - exchange with international libraries (Library of Congress, British Library, )
  - connected catalog entries for original, digital image, research (geo)data (raster- & vector data)
    - Persistent Identifier (**DOI**) for research data

## Providing geodata

- international collaborative **metadata catalogue** (D-A-CH) planned
  - printed plans, maps and map series (like [Kartenportal.ch](http://Kartenportal.ch))
  - printed and electronic literature on cartography, geodata and spatio-temporal research (Bibliographia Cartographica, [bc.staatsbibliothek-berlin.de](http://bc.staatsbibliothek-berlin.de))
  - Digital geodata (vector and raster) (like [Earthworks.stanford.edu](http://Earthworks.stanford.edu))
- repository
  - digital research (geo)data (generated on the basis of our collection) ([kartdok.staatsbibliothek-berlin.de](http://kartdok.staatsbibliothek-berlin.de))
- long term preservation
